
Subject: read_tiff only looks in current working directory?

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Hi folks,

A couple of times now i've run into a strange problem that i haven't had time to pay much attention to until now. I'm simply trying to read a tiff file with READ_TIFF, but this code fails:

```
indir = 'g:\'  
infile = 'test.tif'  
inpath = indir + infile
```

```
;cd,indir
```

```
indata=read_tiff(infile)  
help, indata
```

It fails with a file not found error even though I know that the file is in the location i'm specifying. Also, the error message prints out the full path to the file it's looking for, and it is looking for the correct file name, but the directory path it's looking in is always the current working directory. So, if i uncomment the call to the CD command above, the file gets read with no problem. Has anyone else come across this? This isn't the way it's supposed to work is it?
