Mike writes:

> I've got a problem with an IDL 6.4 installation. When I start idl, !
> path is not defined. This is user specific - the admin who installed
> this on the cluster has no trouble, but I do. Does anyone know where
> the default path is set? If I set IDL_PATH to <IDL_DEFAULT> by hand,
> all is well, but that aught not be necessary...

You could use HELP, /PREFERENCES to identify the location of both the global and local preferences file. One or the other of these appears to be screwed up. In any case, you can set all your IDL preferences in this file, either by hand and simple editing, or by using the PREF_SET and/or PREF_COMMIT commands.
