Hi guys,

quick question: is there a system variable that stores the colour table that I've currently got loaded? So that I can, for example, store that number in a variable within a function, load a new colour table, and then load back the old one before I return back to the previous level? I can't find it in the helpfile if it's there.

e.g.

FUNCTION CTTEST, Data

OldCT = !D.CT ; or whatever it's called

CTLOAD, 0 ; load greyscale

; do something that requires greyscale

S = SIZE (Data, /DIM)

RoI = DEFROI (S[0], S[1])

; and grab back the old colour table

CTLOAD, OldCT

RETURN, RoI

END
