Looks very nice, and I haven't tried it, but I'd call this a "bar plot" more than a histogram plot. If it would be possible to avoid all the vertical bar lines, it would be more useful to me. So essentially it would look like PSYM=10, but bins would go in the correct place, and have neatly finished ends. I usually kludge it by shifting a half bin, and adding endpoints on the X axis.
