> Just curious, how many *.pro files does everyone have?
>

The total number of .pro files I have in my home directory, from:

```
find ~ -name '*.pro' | sed 's/.*V//' | wc -l
```

is 39977.

The total number with unique names coming from:

```
find ~ -name '*.pro' | sed 's/.*V//' | sort | uniq | wc -l
```

is 5479.

Having seen those numbers for the first time, I'm a little worried about the large difference between them number of files and the number of unique files.

If I were to take a conservative guess at the directories I'd include as projects if I ever used the DE then running the above command on the relevant directories gives me 1977 files (1968 unique which is a much nicer discrepancy to have!).
