OK, a workaround:

deep breath

In the workbench, click on Help->Dynamic Help

Click on Index (at the bottom)

Type in your keyword, e.g. 'widget_control' and open out the subtree it finds

Right-click on the helpfile you want to see and select 'Open help in Help Contents' (this is slow-ish on my machine) Bingo

Not exactly intuitive, is it? :-(Chris
