- > I used pointers to share variables between different procedures.
- > When I compile the project it's all right. If I export the project
- > as .sav there is the error "Unable to dereference NULL pointer".
- > Someone just encountered this problem?

My guess would be that the pointer never got filled with data because the program couldn't find the data file. You are catching errors, and popping up a dialog message, right? So you would know if an error occurred in your program during runtime. The data file will, unless you are doing something special, have to be in the same location as the save file.
