- > How about this David: instead of using Fast View for help, I put
- > Dyynamic Help over on the right side of the Workbench, then Minimize
- > it. When I bring it back up by clicking on the Help icon, not the
- > Restore icon, it expands to a readable size. Of course, this works
- > for other views, too - minimize instead of fast view. It does add a
- > little more clutter around the edges, though.

Yes, that works pretty good, too. I just lose another half inch of real estate. (Thanks goodness I have plenty here!)
How come these minimized windows don't **always** go down to the status bar, where we have so much wasted space just **waiting** to be used for something of value?
