I was hoping for a simple keyword to quickly fix this fuss, but it appeared not to be as easy as I initially thought. I fail to see how to change dpi (or ppi) resolution. On whatever format I try (e.g. .eps), when opening the graph in Illustrator, the ppi resolution remains 72 ppi. Can somebody help me out? It would be *very* much appreciated.
