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Are you exporting from iPlot using "bitmap" or "vector" format? If you are doing simple lineplots, then I would recommend exporting to EPS with vector format, because that is independent of resolution. You could then import that into another program like Illustrator and dump it out at 500 DPI or whatever you need. If you have more complicated graphics with surfaces or something, then you'll need to use bitmap format. But in the iTools export wizard, you should be able to set the output dimensions, which should in turn determine the effective DPI.

Hope this helps.
