- > E.g. there is only one version of fsc_color.pro that is used by code in both the "coyote"
- > and "catalyst" directories.

Some of you may have experienced the difficulties inherent in trying to maintain backward compatible code. Of course, I always stay on the cutting edge of things, but occasionally customers have older (MUCH older!) versions of IDL. Catalyst, in particular, seems to run into this problem, and I've had to maintain "old" versions that don't support some of the newest features of the language.
