- > on a file that I previously checked out of my repository.)

Of course, I have all the functionality I want with Subversion and TortoiseSVN. After spending all day writing a tutorial on installing Subclipse in IDL to get Subversion control, I'm just wondering if after I've done all this work, I'm going to end up with the lamest method. :-(
