Yes, this is what I expected too. But when I right-click on the file, I don't have this option under Team. I only have Apply Patch and Show Local History.

It is as if Subclipse doesn't know about this file, so won't give me the right Team menu, which does have an Add to Repository selection. (I see this if I right-click on a file that I previously checked out of my repository.)
