So in the Preferences, go to the Run/Debug > Perspectives tab. Select "IDL Application" in the "Application Types/Launches" section (there are two, don't ask me why). To the right, you should see a "Modes/Perspectives" section with a "[Debug]" droplist. Select "Debug" (in other words, when an "IDL Application" goes into the "Debug" mode, then you are saying you want the Workbench to go into the "Debug" Perspective).
