- > (a) Go to you home directory and then the ".idl/itt" subdirectory.
- > There should be an "idlworkbench-config-idl70" directory. Delete it.

OK, found this an deleted it. Asks where I want my workspace, etc., so this appears to work. No joy with the switching perspective problem, though.

- > (b) Launch the IDL Workbench with the -clean option. This should fix
- > any Eclipse caching issues. Don't always run with that option because
- > the caching speeds the loading of plug-ins at startup.

I'm not sure how to do this. In a command window I changed to the C:\Program Files\ITT\IDL70\IDLDE directory and then typed: "idlde.exe -clean"

IDL started, but I was told it couldn't find a file named "clean", so I guess this didn't work. Can you tell me how to launch the Workbench with the clean option?
