What I would like to do is to find out the name of the top level IDL procedure so that I can put it via xyouts on the plots it produces:

pro junk,xxx

... various other routines and functions called to do one thing or another ...

plot, some\_vector

.... something magical happens here so that I have a variable (eg, program\_name)

that tells me the name of the program that produced this plot is "junk"

sub\_xyouts,.1,.1,' name of program that produced this plot is '+program\_name,/normal

return end

It seems like the help command would do this somehow, but darn if I can figure out how it might be done.
