- > Templates are a subset of what Eclipse (and thus the IDL Workbench)
- > calls "Content Assist." To insert a content assist item, you press
- > Ctrl-Space. One of two things will happen:

- > - If you have already typed all of the name of the item you want
- > to insert (or enough to identify it uniquely), the entire thing
- > will just be inserted.

I presume this is part of the Auto Insert business that has to be turned on for the Templates. Do I have that right?

If so, how do I get that to work? Do I type the name of the template? The first characters of the line of the template? I've tried everything I can think of to do, all without success.
