Standalone IDL support is not available for ingesting GRID files--you must have ENVI+IDL. Because GRID is an ESRI proprietary format, you also must have an active and available ArcGIS license on your workstation to be able to read GRID files in ENVI. ENVI will check to make sure that the license is there before it will let you work with GRID files.

There is a patch for ENVI 4.3 that fixes the crashing issue when attempting to open GRID files. You can obtain it by contacting ITT VIS Technical Support at techsupport@ittvis.com.
