- > appear as in a 2D plot (as the OP originally requested) one could then still use
- > charsize=1.0 and retain more display space for the plot.

Well, I always position graphics with the POSITION keyword, so CHARSIZE doesn't affect the location of the plot. Who thought plot margins based on character size was a good idea, though?
