I have a feeling you are not running the code I sent you. :-)

If you comment out the PLOT line, it's anyone's guess what kind of values you are getting. The PLOT line *is* the essential element here.

Well, fractional pixels are good, aren't they? I probably should have used ROUND, rather than FIX in my code, but they should have been reported in integers, just so I didn't scare you. The point is, I didn't tell you *what* size window to create. This works wherever you want to display the image.
