- > call" error.
- > I don't know which keyword parameters, neither which routine....
- > I can't locate the error. It's a nightmare!

The last time I ran into someone this frustrated about error handling, a "friend" had given him a startup file that set !QUIET=1. Let me tell you, it is **very** hard to debug a program with that turned on! :-)

But this does sound strange. I've never known of an error like this, except those coming out of iTools. Can you give us more details about the circumstances of where this error occurs?
