Hi there,

this is my first question to this newsgroup. I could not find my problem in the archives.

I want to create a dicom-file in the HSV-color format. We have the toolkit and I can create the files, but they do not contain what I want them to.

I pass a an array with size (3,25,25) to the method. The three fields contain the values for hue, saturation and value. Writing the file with

and committing it produces a dcm-file with the size 25x25. Looking at the file with a dicom-viewer shows that the first pixel-column of the created image contains the values of the first row of the first field of the input data.

Hard to describe...

Goal of the HSV-image should be to encode three different parameters of an examination in one image.

So my question: Does anybody know if I have to rearrange my passed-in data? IDL-Version is 6.3.
