> ... etc ...

> compiled and then used, eg:

> wave> demo,file.1234
>
> which would open 'file.1234' in my directory. I would prefer to NOT
> do this from a C-shell script ... I'd like to do it within wave.
>
> thanx --dcarney@lerc.nasa.gov
