Here is code that works:

```
image = Loaddata(16)
s = Size(image, /Dimensions)
pos = [0.1, 0.1, 0.9, 0.9]
TVImage, image, Position=pos, /Keep_Aspect
Plot, [0,1], XRange=[0,s[1]], YRange=[0,s[2]], $
    NoData=1, NoErase=1, XStyle=1, YStyle=1, Position=pos
Cursor, x, y, /Data, /Down & Print, Round(x), Round(y)
```

I've left the axis there, so you can see how it works a little better. :-)
