Subject: Postscript device weirdness

Hi all-

I was wondering if someone could explain to me why the postscript device behaves in a certain particularly strange way. I've been trying to size and position a plot for print-out using the following code, which will leave the offsets incorrectly set as their default values:

```
device,filename='plot.ps',/inches,xoffset=3,yoffset=2,xsize= 5,ysize=5
```

When I print out the postscript file, the plot sits on the bottom left corner of the page, as if I hadn't set the xoffset and yoffset keywords at all. However, the following code works fine:

```
device,filename='plot.ps',/inches,xsize=5,ysize=5,xoffset=2, yoffset=3
```

What I'm wondering is why on earth the device procedure cares about the order of the parameters. I'm not aware of any other IDL procedures that behave this way. Is there some reason why it does, or is it some kind of bug in IDL 6.3?

Thanks for any insight anyone can provide.
