This is true, but partially compensated for a project's ability to update the IDL path preference when a project is opened or closed. Of course, you have to have this turned on for a project.

As I expected, though, the ability to the update path preference works better in theory than in practice. Unless you have the discipline to maintain only one version of any particular file (and who does!?) I find there is always a question of which file I have opened. As far as I know, there is no good way to tell. I always have to close all my files and start over, opening them up one by one so I am sure. :-(
