```
> PRO MODBUS__DEFINE
>     struct = { MODBUS, Host:"hasgksscdkal.desy.de", Port:502, tid:0L }
> END
```

Be careful here. Those values "hasgksscdkal.desy.de", 502, and 0L are only used for their type. The actual values are thrown away. Normally, I do something like:

```
struct = { MODBUS, host: "", port: 0, tid: 0L }
```

so I don't fool myself.

I second that you should read David's article (N_ELEMENTS is probably what you want to use in GKSSBC::INIT).
