Hi,

I'm relatively new to IDL and am not able to figure out an issue dealing with NaNs in statistics computed from my image.

Here's the problem:

I wrote an IDL script to compute basic statistics of a MODIS image that i have processed.

The areas outside my study area have been set to NaN because i don't want them to be considered

while computing statistics in ENVI.

But, when i use the Image_statistics procedure in IDL, i'm not able to ignore the NaN and hence all the

basic stats show values of NaN(like max=NaN, min= NaN etc..)

Expected result:

To calculate the true max,min values of the image without considering the pixels which are set to NaN.

Anybody has any idea how to go about fixing this problem? my initial thought was to create a NaN mask, but i want to get some ideas flowing.
