In terms of self-compiling I'm a beginner, so please excuse my ignorance if this is written somewhere in the manual, I couldn't find it easily at least:

So far I put every procedure I consider to be useful enough for more than one task in its extra file, so that if it's called, IDL compiles it automatically, having the procedure and file name identical.

But after a while, the number of files I have keeps growing.

I wonder if there's another elegant way to keep things auto-compilable without me having to compile some kind of library before I start working on a task using my "library" of useful procedures.

Am I missing something simple?
