Can't help with this, but we were trying to use IDLnetURL to ftp a simple PNG file. It works fine to one ftp server, but crashes IDL (seg fault or bus error, depending on hardware) to a different ftp server. Command line ftp works fine to both servers.

We might be doing something wrong, but we still shouldn't be able to crash IDL. :-)

We have filed a bug report (and switched to SPAWNing a curl process).
