Just to throw in that every terminal has a maximum, I pulled the "checking the maximum length of command line arguments" out of a configure script and find that OSX terminal does have a size limit but I bet you wont hit it.

I am sure that IDL has a limit based on the size of a buffer that is initialized in the source code for IDL (written in C I guess but don't know). If I am right on this, one could petition ITT to increase this buffer for the next release of IDL if this is a issue for folks.
