Thanks, David,

I now have 2GB of RAM, and the problem persists, but I've narrowed it down. (The ITTVis people are helping me as well.)

It turns out that I can make the Workbench reliably hang when text in the program window is selected and I attempt to copy/cut/paste with control-cxv. If it doesn't happen on the first or second copy/paste then it will happen on the third, fourth, or fifth.

## Testing a few things:

- 1. When starting a clean, fresh Workbench, with none of my usual apps, the problem goes away.
- 2. With my old Workbench, and the startup file removed, none of my usual GUIs launch and the problem also goes away.
- 3. Bring back the GUIs, and I bring back the hang. Remember that when it hangs, it's on the Workbench that's frozen. All of the GUI apps/events are running fine.
