Thanks, David,

I now have 2GB of RAM, and the problem persists, but I've narrowed it down. (The ITTVis people are helping me as well.)

It turns out that I can make the Workbench reliably hang when text in the program window is selected and I attempt to copy/cut/paste with control-cxv. If it doesn't happen on the first or second copy/paste then it will happen on the third, fourth, or fifth.

Testing a few things:

1. When starting a clean, fresh Workbench, with none of my usual apps, the problem goes away.
  2. With my old Workbench, and the startup file removed, none of my usual GUIs launch and the problem also goes away.
  3. Bring back the GUIs, and I bring back the hang.
- Remember that when it hangs, it's on the Workbench that's frozen. All of the GUI apps/events are running fine.
