Hi Du,

It sounds like you want to save the actual state of your iTool, including the data and visualizations. If you use David & Vince's methods, you are actually saving the IDL code that creates the iTool, but not the actual iTool state. I don't think that's what you want.

You *should* be able to simply save into a .isv file, and that should save all of the data and visualizations needed for that particular iTool.

Can you give an example of either data or properties that are not getting saved? If so, that would be a bug, and we could fix it.
