- > software circles they will be in the majority).

Now I see why GPL is called viral: a few dozen lines long interface can infect a 200,000 lines program :-)

- > My personal opinion and understanding of the GPL would be that this would be
- > a violation but I'm not an expert on these things by any stretch of the
- > imagination.

> I would be very cautious about releasing a FFTW3 plug-in for FL.

>

OK, to be on the safe side. I will drop FFTW3, it was meant as a useful example program only. I will choose an other library with a more friendly licence. And probably FL users will write their own FFTW3 DLM, they can not infect FL:-)

- > You can always write to the FSF for advice and/or contact the FFTW3 people to
- > see if they'll make an exception for FL.

>

The FSF advice would be to release FL under GPL. And after reading the FFTW pages I think the chance of obtaining an exception is exactly 0%. So, I will not use FFTW.
