> Here are the three errors I most commonly see in IDL programs.

I apologize for not having read all the replies - sorry if this is duplicating others.

1) multiple copies of a routine.

I have done this a few times, with older "utility" programs that somehow get duplicated in different parts of the path. Which is fine cause IDL always

uses the "first" one - until edits make the two copies branch independently and

then function calls don't do what i think they are doing.

2) running off arrays - (depending on system settings) two cases, a) one where IDL repeats the last element and doesn't issue an error. b) where you multiply two arrays and the longer one gets truncated.
