> IF filename NE " THEN Write_JPEG, filename, snapshot, True=1

Seems to me that you don't want to give the user a choice to make the filename. So, why not just have them choose a directory?

dirname = Dialog_Pickfile(/Directory)
if strlen(dirname) gt 0 then File=dirname+path_sep()+uname
+ '-' + info.file_name + '.jpeg'
```
