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Following my dumb Q about MPEGs a couple of days ago it was suggested I'd be better off with AVIs, so I've moved on to AVIs and picked up Ronn Kling's AVI code from <http://www.kilvarock.com./freeware/dlms/dlms.htm>

It seems to do the generate test okay, and subsequently read back the avi it generated, but everything goes pear-shaped and IDL crashes horribly if I try to import a short AVI I've just saved from a movie capture program called PowerDirector, using the maximum quality option. That movie plays okay in VLC and Windows Media Player.

It falls over reproducibly on different machines, and as well as 7.0 I loaded up a copy of 6.3 just to make sure nothing had changed in IDL to break it.

Anyone have any ideas what might be going wrong?
