Dear group users,

I am rather new to IDL and completely new to the GRIB data format. I have tried to figure out how to read GRIB data into IDL and have found several packages on the web, seemingly all based on the rather old wgrib c programme. The latest package I found at ITTs webpage by Andy Pursch (<http://www.ittvis.com/codebank/search.asp?FID=488>), and it was easy to install and seems to be running fine. My problem, however, is that the documentation is quite poor and I cannot understand the object structure created. For example, I cannot see how to identify which parameter is in each "record", or what time of day it represents. Also, I work with ECMWF data which apparently use different parameter codes than the official WMO. Can anybody help with some good advice on how to advance?
