> when I enter any commands at the prompt and hit enter, the commands just
> disappear. They do not show up in the console log and variables set do not
> show up in the variable view. "?" does not open help either. It seems that
> there is no connectivity between the DE and the opserver process. I tried
> restarting a few times making sure that no orphaned idlde.exe or
> idl_opserver.exe were still running. The problem remained. I also
> reinstalled twice and the problem is reproducible. I have IDL 7 installed
> on several systems in the past and never seen this problem. Does anyone
> have any idea about how to approach this problem?
