> So my question is how do i pass the data_path?

You can't pass it directly into the program in the way you are trying to do it. Rather, you have to use a -arg command line switch on the IDL command you are using and pass it that way.

Inside your program, you can recover the command line argument (or arguments) using the function COMMAND_LINE_ARGS.
