As is the norm, I think that David is right here. Your command: spawn, 'mkdir '+output\_dir, message will not have any output unless there is an error in the creation. So the statement:

IF (string(message)) then begin is a little odd as you are testing "(nothing), with IF. You probably want something more like:

IF strlen(String(message)) ne 0 then begin ;; print an error message and go about you business

The reason that you are never hitting the STOP is that the IF statement is never true.
