Hi Folks,

Anyone seen this. I'm running a program on a Windows machine. I want to know if a particular pixmap window is still open. The window index number is something like 75. To check whether it is still open or not, I get the window "state" like this:

DEVICE, WINDOW_STATE=theState

This is suppose to be "an array containing one element for each possible window". If it has a 1 in the right slot, the window is open and available.

windowlsOpen = theState[75]

All well and good, but when I run my program, the State variable changes from a 139-element array to a 65-element array within seconds of running the exact same code!

I've done this many times, and I can find no pattern in the output. Oh wait!! It is apparently Morse code. Let's see...

S-W-I-T-C-H T-O M-A-T-L-A ...

Oh, never mind. I could have guessed that. :-(
