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Make a file, let's say regrid_mozt42_tlr

```
public1:/home/tlr/idl>cat regrid_mozt42_tlr
> regrid_mozt42_tlr
> exit
public1:/home/tlr/idl> idl regrid_mozt42_tlr
```

```
> IDL Version 7.0 (linux x86 m32). (c) 2007, ITT Visual Information Solutions
> ...
> IDL> regrid_mozt42_tlr
> % Compiled module: REGRID_MOZT42_TLR.
> ...
> Done.
public1:/home/tlr/idl>
```

You can also include commands like .compile etc in the file
regrid_mozt42_tlr in case it can not resolve all dependencies.

```
public1:/home/tlr/idl>cat regrid_mozt42_tlr
> .compile 'myfunc1.pro'
...
> .compile 'mypro1.pro'
...
> .compile 'regrid_mozt42_tlr.pro'
> regrid_mozt42_tlr
> exit
```
