well... Bob gave you two solutions already
0:s[n] and
indgen(s[n])

Now if you really want to use the *, you might want to have a look at
the command "execute"

```
IDL> a = '*'
IDL> b = indgen(3,3)
IDL> c = '1'
IDL> tmp= execute('e = b[' + c + ',' + a +']')
IDL> print,e
1
4
7
```

but be aware of the limitations of this command (read the help)
