- > patch installer for your platform. Note that there are only two
- > changes to the API: the addition of the CDF_SET_MD5CHECKSUM
- > routine and the addition of the READONLY keyword to the CDF OPEN
- > routine. All other changes to the libraries should be transparent to
- > IDL code.

- > Since the scientific data format libraries are third-party code and
- > packaged in dynamically loadable modules, they can be updated
- > separately from the IDL's core functions, and sometimes are.

OK, that makes (some) sense, I guess. But I've already been confused, since I had no idea that the "update" didn't update what I thought (and hoped) I was updating. (Not to mention the trouble I have getting my sys admin guy to DO the updates, only to have to go back to him now and explain that we have to do it *again*!)

Doesn't having two nearly identical numbers to worry about bother anyone at ITTVIS? Maybe you are used to thinking in double precision already. But my head can hardly hold integers these days. :-)
