Hi,

I'm looking for a little guidance with regards to getting IDL 7.0 Workbench running smoothly on a 32bit Linux system.

The issue is that as a normal user, the idl_opserver process that gets started by the Workbench dies right away.

This results in commands entered at the command line simply disappearing and never getting executed. Also, I am unable to save new files or create new projects and on exiting the Workbench, java hangs and my CPU usage goes to 100%. I have to kill the java process manually.

Has anyone else come across this issue and does someone know of a fix or workaround?
