The OP wanted a quick fix that imported the contents of a dynamically written batch file into a main-level program. This whole scenario is not allowed in the VM.

If this were something more permanent (maybe for an application in the VM), I would place the data in a data file, not a batch file. Then have my code read the data into a hash table and use that to look up "variable names" (I assume the variable names are supposed to actually represent some other quantity).
