> just can't seem to get the axis appearing, although it was there when
> I ran my script yesterday. And this is the most bizarre thing to me?

> Maybe I should just try to plot the variables name with XYOUTS as a
> string, on the location I want them to be on? As there is no direct
> relation with the values shown in the plot...

If the axis you are trying to draw contains no direct connection to the plot, then I would say the possibility of it showing up anywhere you can see it is vanishingly small. The fact that it showed up yesterday just proves that the possibility is not zero. :-)
