- > I have tried to used the "Axis" command, to plot my own defined X and
- > Y axis. Yesterday, the axis were appearing on the plot, today, this
- > command doesn't result in any axis appearing in my .eps figure? Any
- > idea what could be the cause of this?

In general, you need to have set up a data coordinate system before you can use the AXIS command. I expect it is being drawn, but it is so tiny you can't see it. :-)

I would try using a PLOT command with the /NODATA keyword set to draw your axes. The PLOT command will establish the data coordinate system for you.
